Sub: Proposal of General Officer Commanding, 4 Corps

Please find enclosed the below proposals received from General Officer Commanding, 4 Corps:

A. Coaching for Sainik/Military schools, Rashtriya Military schools and other Military Educational Institutions

- It is stated in the proposal that mentoring for Sainik and Military School entrance exams has successfully helped youth in Assam's border areas. In the last three years, 19 students from Sonitpur have passed these exams, gaining confidence and discipline.
- They have identified motivated students from several districts, including Udaiguri and Kokrajhar. Training centres are proposed for Tezpur and Missamari to provide academic coaching and application assistance.
- Army will provide administrative support, while the estimated cost for instructors is ₹1.5 crore. This program empowers youth through quality education and national service.

B. Coaching for undergraduate students (Boys and Girls) for selection as officer in Army, Navy, Air force, CPF, CISF, ITBP, SSB and Railway Protection Force

- Gajraj Corps has proposed to launch a structured coaching and mentorship programme for graduate and under graduate students of Assam with collaboration with professional faculty at Tezpur and Tamulpur in ₹3 crore, to prepare students for CDS/OTA and CAPFs, SSC, National Fire Service Collage and other competitive examinations.
- Gajraj Corps has already undertaken extensive awareness and motivational outreach as preparatory phase.

You are requested to examine the matter and take appropriate action and submit a report within 15 days. Hon'ble Chief Minister will also review the progress in the matter in due course of time.

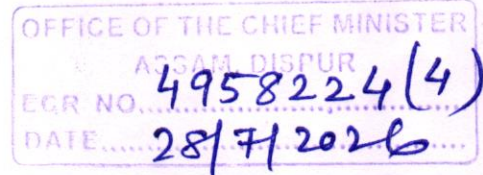

Respected Sir,

1. Please accept my heartiest greetings on having won the Assembly elections with a stupendous majority and having taken over the Chief Minister making it a "Hat-Trick with Century", to lead the state once again with your grand vision not only for Assam, but for the entire North East.
2. I would also take this opportunity to thank you for inviting me to your historic and grand swearing in ceremony which will always remain etched in our memory.
3. I feel blessed to be back to my Karm Bhoomi of Assam, with you at the helm of affairs once again, which gives me strength and energy to take your vision forward from where we had left in Oct 2024. Before assuming my appointment on 01 Apr 26, I had met the Chief Secretary and the DGP, where we discussed issues concerning security related to illegal migrants, encroachment of land by illegal migrants, establishment of Defence Corridor between Siliguri and Dibrugarh, inter-agency coordination to include Para Military and State Police Forces and, capacity augmentation in border and sensitive areas. COACHING FOR SAINIK/ MILITARY SCHOOLS, RASHTRIYA MILITARY SCHOOLS AND OTHER MILITARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

1. **Statement of Problem.** Investing in the youth of border areas and unprivileged sectors of Assam through targeted mentoring for the All India Sainik School Entrance Exams (AISSEE) & Rashtriya Military School Entrance Exam has emerged as a powerful transformative social outreach, led by the Formation on behalf of the Indian Army. This programme has successfully bridged the educational gaps in infrastructure at remote border regions offering quality academic training, motivational sessions & personnel develop that has instilled discipline & confidence in the mentorees. **A total of 19 students from Sonitpur have cleared the entrance exam in last three years.**
2. **Proposal.** Gajraj Corps is launching a Collaborative, Well-Structured Coaching-cum-Mentorship Programme. Under this initiative, in association with highly qualified and experienced professional faculty, aspiring students from Assam will be prepared for the entrance examinations of Sainik Schools, Rashtriya Military Schools and other military educational institutions, enabling them to pursue a career in the Indian Armed Forces and serve the nation.
3. A significant number of willing and motivated students from districts of Udalguri, Tamulpur, Kokrajhar, Sonitpur and Bishwanath Chariali have already been identified and have expressed their desire to join Sainik Schools and Military Schools. Gajraj Corps, with the support of the Government and local administration, is committed to providing sustained guidance and support to these students throughout their preparation journey. This initiative represents an investment in the future of the nation by creating greater opportunities for talented youth from border and remote areas.
4. A centralised training centre at Tezpur and Missamari is proposed, where professional faculty will conduct structured coaching and mentorship for interested local students included students of villages adopted by Indian Army in Assam. The Programme will include assistance in application and form-filling, regular academic coaching, continuous monitoring of progress, performance assessment and comprehensive preparation for the entrance examinations.
5. **Financial Implication.** The Army will ensure the necessary training and administrative support for the students throughout the programme. In addition, adequate training and administrative arrangement will also be provided for the instructors and faculty involved in conducting the coaching which will approximately cost Rs 1.5 Cr.
6. **Benefits Accrued.** Through this initiative, the Indian Army reaffirm its commitment to working alongside government in investing the nation's future by empowering the Youth of Assam with quality education, mentorship and opportunity to excel and serve the country.

COACHING FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS (BOYS AND GIRLS) FOR SELECTION AS OFFICER IN ARMY, NAVY, AIRFORCE, CRPF, CISF, ITBP, SSB AND RAILWAY PROTECTION FORCE

1. **Statement of Problem.** Despite possessing immense potential, motivation and strong inclination towards serving the nation, a large segment of youth of Assam is unable to qualify competitive examination due to lack of structured guidance, professional coaching and sustained mentorship. Many deserving graduate and undergraduate students particularly from remote and rural areas, remain unaware of the numerous career opportunities available through the Armed Forces, CAPFs and other government services.
2. Although the initiative such as Super – 30 programme at Tamulpur were undertaken in collaboration with the government of Assam, the outcome have not been commensurate with expectations. **A total of eight students of Super-30 programme have cleared the UPSC entrance exam and one has already joined NDA.** There remains a significant requirement for a professionally managed, systematic, and result-oriented coaching and mentoring programme that can prepare Assam youth for national level competitive examinations.
3. **Proposal.** Gajraj Corps proposed to launch a Structured Coaching and Mentorship Programme for Graduate and Undergraduate students of Assam with collaboration with professional faculty at Tezpur and Tamulpur zone of Assam in Rs 3 Crore, to prepare students for Combined Defence Services (CDS/ OTA) and CAPFs, SSC, National Fire Service Collage and other competitive examinations. As part of preparatory phase, extensive awareness and motivational outreach has already been undertaken by Gajraj Corps. The response received from students have been highly encouraging, indicating a strong desire among the youth of Assam to join the Armed Forces and contribute towards the nation.
4. **Benefits Accrued.** The proposed initiative provides a structured and professional coaching through experienced faculty and subject matter experts. Well designed study module, regular assessment and performance monitoring and career guidance throughout the preparation cycle will be given to the students. Provision of boarding, lodging and other essential facilities during the training period will be taken care of for needy candidates. The initiative is expected to be significantly increase the representation of Assam youth in the Armed Forces, CAPFs and other prestigious national institutions while contributing towards nation building and youth empowerment.
